

WISCONSIN GOVERNMENT FINANCE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP ANNOUNCEMENTS POLICY

In order to stay connected and provide value to its members, WGFOA needs to communicate with its members. The preferred method of communication is electronically. WGFOA is not and will not be an advocacy group.

WGFOA will utilize the following methods of communicating with its members:

E-mail

WGFOA board members will have the ability to send out e-mail blasts to its members as deemed appropriate. Criteria to be used to determine appropriateness are:

- Notification of upcoming training and conference opportunities.
- News and information from national GFOA that is appropriate to be communicated to the members.
- Other information deemed appropriate to be communicated to the members as a whole by the board.
- WGFOA board members will make the determination of what is appropriate or not.

Conference presentations

The WGFOA board will make conference presentations available to members on the member's only section of the WGFOA website shortly after each conference has ended.

Policies and procedures

The WGFOA board will make policies and procedures available to its members on its website.

Job postings

On the WGFOA public section of its website, WGFOA will make information available about job openings in member organizations.

Members will be able to forward a job posting announcement to a designated WGFOA board member to post on the website. Only members may post announcements here. Non-members may not.

WGFOA may enter into reciprocity agreements with other GFOA chapters. If it does so, job openings may be posted to any and all of the other chapters included in the reciprocity agreement. If another chapter charges for a posting, the member organization desiring to have a job posting placed on the site will need to determine whether or not to have that site included in the posting.

Requests by other organizations

WGFOA receives periodic requests from other professional organizations to publish an announcement to its members regarding upcoming events, etc. The WGFOA board will use the following criteria to determine if the posting should be allowed or not:

- How closely aligned is the mission and purpose of the other organization to WGFOA's mission and purpose?
- What is the benefit to WGFOA's membership if this announcement was or was not made?
- How would this announcement be perceived by its members?
